Use of School Premises

The property of the school district may be used for those purposes specified in Education Law §414 (1). No outside organization or group may be allowed to conduct religious services or religious instruction on school premises after school. However, the use of school premises by outside organizations or groups after school for the purpose of discussing religious material or material which contains a religious viewpoint or for distributing such material is permissible.

IT IS FURTHER CERTIFIED THAT THE MEETING, ENTERTAINMENT, OR OCCASION DOES NOT PERTAIN TO RELIGIOUS SERVICE, RELIGIOUS INSTRUCTION, RELIGIOUS ACTIVITIES, PURPOSES OR HAVE A RELIGIOUS THEME. THIS PROHIBITION INCLUDES:

- Uses where any denominational tenet or doctrine is advocated or taught
- Activities which relate to or manifest faithful devotion to an acknowledged ultimate reality or deity
- worship or sacrifice
- performing services or acts in accordance with beliefs, principles, doctrines, canons, rules or regulations of a religious organization.

IT IS UNDERSTOOD THAT THE SCHOOL DISTRICT RESERVIES THE RIGHT TO REVOKE THE PERMISSION TO USE THE SCHOOL PREMISES AND TO CANCEL THAT ACTIVITY IF IT IS DETERMINED THAT THE CERTIFICATION IS INACCURATE.
