## ARBITY BASEBALL 1997

This season was the conclusion of our "Two Year Plan" which began last year. Although we won twice as many games as last season, we failed in our goals of winning the league and competing in sectionals. With eight returning starters, we felt those were realistic goals. Our team batting average improved by over 50 points, but out team fielding and pitching did not. I also felt that our lack of team speed hindered our fielding as well as our baserunning.

Initially there were 19 players trying out for the squad. For various reasons 5 chose not to continue early in our pre-season, therefore we kept the remaining 14 to represent our school. Early in the schedule it became clear that junior Tim Vanderpool would not get a lot of playing time to improve his skills. Therefore, we sent him down to the junior varsity to home his catching skills and get times at bat. Tim was very agreeable to this so he could play.

In pre-season Howard Reeve showed behavior in practice and our scrimmage at Greene that was detrimental to the team. A contract that was signed by him and his mom stating unacceptable behavior and its consequenses was drawn up. This same contract was issued to the whole team to make everyone accountable. I felt that this helped certain players and kept them under control. Except for a couple of other situations. I was very pleased with the team's behavior on the bus and at games.

I was disappointed in the overall attitude of Bobby Hurlburt. He seemed to have a negative attitude about his own ability and skills as well as negative comments regarding players from other teams. This must improve if he is going to help us next season.

I was very pleased with the effort and ability of Josh Pouch who worked his way into the starting line-up the last 10 games.

This was a difficult season due to the lack of a home field to practice or play on. The time and effort to prepare the field at Cole Park was appreciated, but the dimensions just were not acceptable for a varsity baseball field. This was never more evident than in our 19-16 lose against Whitney Point where 20 homeruns were hit.

I would like to thank the Physical Education staff (Mr. Derr. Mrs. B-Smith and Mr. Hamilton) for allowing the batting cage to stay up during our season. I know this must have caused some inconveniences.

I appreciated the effort Mr. Hamilton put in utilizing the athletic budget so that we were able to get new modified uniforms and much needed equipment. Another soft-toss net is still needed as well as a pprotective screen for infield practice. A new batting cage with the cable and pulley system would be more efficient than what we have now.
