SEASON IN REVIEW 2006

Pre-season began the end of January. Players did not take as much advantage of this as in the past. Most players were playing winter sports and must have needed a day off.

The regular season began March 6 with 18 players. The first cut was made four days later. Eventually 16 players were kept. Players 15 and 16 were agreeable to their limited play possibility, the just wanted to be part of the team.

We won the season opener against Walton, who would eventually win the Division II championship going 10-0. We were behind by 7 runs after the first half inning. We scored 4 runs in our half and eventually won the game in the bottom of the 7th with a suicide squeeze. We would actually win 3 of our first 4 wins in a similar fashion, winning in our last at bat!!

That earned him the start in our 1st round sectional game at Seton (NYSEG Stadium). We were seeded 9 and Seton was seeded 8. Again our pitching was adequate, but our defense and offense let us down. We lost 6-3.

We finally got up our outside batting cage during Spring Break. We used the money raised during our 2005 golf fundraiser. The materials cost over \$800. I'd like to thank Jim Bulger for cutting pipes, drilling holes for bolts and sleeves and assembling the framework. He also assisted in putting the sleeves in the ground for the poles. Two varsity players (Nate Warner and Andy Wahl) did community service time to help put the sleeves in the ground and erect the poles.

I would also like to thank Billy Roys and Dale Robinson for their volunteerism. Billy is a great help working with the pitchers and catchers. Dale always does a nice job keeping the scorebook.

Money from this years fundraiser need to be used to replace our "Ken Griffey" hitting station. A left handed catchers mitt is needed for next year. Baseball pants for each level are also needed. New bats for each level will also be needed. Donation to the Summer Baseball can also be made with our fundraiser money.

Pitching for next season appears to be adequate to good. Must improve our defense and offense to make a run for the title next year.

I will apply for the Varsity position next season.
