SEASON IN REVIEW 2009

Pre-season began on January 11 for pitchers and catchers and continued for seven Sunday afternoons, as it has for the past 10 years. There were 4 to 10 players each week. The majority of the players were from the JV and modified levels. Ryan Dalpiaz and Vincent Gatto were the only 2 varsity players that consistently participated. Ryan also went to the RBI Camp in Endicott during this time. These programs were instrumental for his pitching success this season.

Our regular season began on March 9th. We lost one of our top returning pitchers to an off season injury and a second who left the district. These loses impacted us from being team which could vie for the division to a rebuilding year. We also lost Shane Hayes who was our starting catcher and co-captain from last year with an elbow problem. It was finally diagnosed in late winter and surgery was performed in May. These 3 players (2 seniors and a junior) had to be replaced by underclassmen.

There were 8 juniors and seniors who tried out for the squad. Two of these players (Casey Hine and Marcus Williams) had no organized baseball experience. Casey completed the season and played very well in the outfield. Marcus decided to leave the team late in April. Senior Russell Brown left after one practice and junior Alex Tanner left after 5 practices. Sophomore Russell Anderson was brought up at the very start. Three others were brought up to fill the roster. When it appeared there was additional need at the catcher position, 8th grader Mason Dean was moved up from J.V. The initial roster had 1 senior, 6 juniors, 4 sophomores and 1 8th grader. After one game 10th grader Travis Snow was sent back down to get more experience.

The roster remained the same until Marcus Williams left the team. We would bring up selected J.V. players from game to game depending on our needs. At the end of the season sophomore Cole Canfield was dismissed from the team due to his poor attitude and poor attendance. The last straw was when he was told that if did not hustle he would be replaced. His response was..."go ahead". Sophomores Jared Decker, David Fehrman and Travis Snow were brought up for our final four games including our sectional game against Thomas Edison.

Junior pitchers Chad Baxter and Ryan Dalpiaz did the bulk of our pitching. They each won three games. One of Ryan's wins was a "no-hitter" against Whitney Point. Eric Frayer performed admirably as our third pitcher.

Our schedule this year was very difficult. It included three STAC teams and a very tough division with three top seeded Class D teams (3 Hancock, 4 Afton and 6 Deposit). We played a total of 23 games including our sectional game versus Thomas Edison.

The 2010 season will be my final season coaching varsity baseball at HCS. It will be a more successful one due to our returning pitchers. We will improve on our 4 error average per game and our 5.6 run average per game.
