Dear Harpurville Families:

The Food Service Programs in our local schools have worked diligently to create a plan that provides the opportunity for children to have access to meals throughout the period of school closure due to the coronavirus (COVID-19). The meals are available to all children ages 18 and under. Below is some important information related to the opportunity for accessing meals:

- In Harpurville, meals can be picked up near the main entrance of the elementary school from 10 a.m.-1 p.m. Simply drive up to the canopy where the meals are being distributed to receive the meals. Our staff will deliver the meals to your vehicle; please do not get out of your vehicle. **Two free meals per day, one breakfast meal and one lunch meal, will be provided per day for each child.**

- Meals will continue to be provided every day, Monday – Friday, during the period of closure.
- Feel free to use a “teamwork” approach for friends and neighbors if you’re going to pick up meals for each other.

We are so pleased that a plan has been established to make meals readily available to our students during this challenging time period.
