Grab-and-go meals continue this week with one additional meal served for the weekend...

Our meal distribution plan in the district will be the same for this week as it was for last week. This includes the locations and times that we've been at the different drop-off sites within the district too. Again, you will notice that we are serving meals on Monday and Thursday of this week and each person will receive 3 breakfast and 3 lunch meals to cover each of the respective days (Monday-Wednesday and then Thursday-Saturday).

I sent out an all call and email on Thursday of last week, but I want to make sure everyone remains aware of the current timeline that's been established by the Governor for our tentative return to school. The latest Executive Order has schools closed through May 15th (meaning the return date would be on the 18th). We're keeping our fingers crossed that the health of our society allows us to return to school. This is especially important for our seniors, the Class of 2020!

There is still responsibility and accountability for the students in terms of making sure they successfully complete their coursework during the period of closure.
