Body: Factors that allowed the Patriots to Win...

- 1) Britain made mistakes!
    - Gen Howe - red uniforms
    - Broad's Hill
    - Bunker Hill
    - charging fortified hills
    - broad daylight
    - "win" but Patriot win psychological battle
  - 2) Br. had misunderstood war
    - ↳ traditional war
    - mercenaries - Ger. soldiers "Hessians"
    - ↳ & drive than Patriots
  - 3) Patriots Strengths\*
    - \* G. Washington's leadership
    - ↳ skillful retreats
  - 4) Perseverance = new
    - Women took on roles
    - Soldiers - little supplies - died w/very little
- [1776 - GB take NYC  
Wash retreats to NJ  
↳ counterattack → Dec. 26<sup>th</sup> = Trenton  
↳ Am victory
- Princeton - 1777 - Am win  
Philly - 1777 - Am lose
- Saratoga \* Br. lose = turning Pt in the war
- Fr. become official allies w/US (Feb 1778)  
+ Sp
- Frontier - NAS supporting GB  
Patriots destroyed NAS villages
