PRESENTATION OF THE 2016-17 PROPOSED BUDGET

Superintendent Rullo presented the 2016-17 proposed budget. He reviewed our budget goals, projected revenues and anticipated tax levy increase of 3.02% which is equal to about a \$21.65 increase on a \$50,000 home. He explained the 2% property tax cap and why we are not exceeding it with an increase of 3.02%.

Audience members asked questions related to salaries and stipends for staff members. Also, **BOCES** costs including the Central Business Office were discussed.

Mr. McLaughlin reported on each specific Federal grant and what expenses are covered under them.

Mr. Rullo stated that the 2016-17 budget of \$20,363,159 reflects our spending plan and we are going to stick to the approved budget.
